Dear John,

As you know we just completed the above comprehensive evaluation of your new Sense' skin care line. I wanted to be one of the first to share with you some of the exciting results from this study. The results are very good and certainly some of the best we have seen. The key findings at week 8 were as follows:

Clinically, skin dryness was completely eliminated
Clinically, skin smoothness improved by as much as 49% during the 8 week study
Moisture levels increased by 90%, as measured by a NOVA meter
Instrumentally, skin elasticity increased by as much as 60% during the 8 week study.

As I noted earlier, these results are quite remarkable, especially given the time of year you were forced to test in, and you are to be congratulated for creating, what appears clinically, to be an excellent skin care line. In addition, as I mentioned to Kevin Fuller, when comparing the old regimen to the new, in certain key areas the reformulation appears to produce better overall results than the previous formulas.
